### How to register for Graduation

#### Register online via the Student Hub.

You must register online by **Thursday 11 April 2019** if you wish to attend the graduation.

If you do not register by then, you will be graduated in absentia and will not be allowed to attend the ceremony.

You can choose to graduate at a later ceremony in Auckland or Dunedin, but you must graduate within 18 months of completing your qualification.

#### How to hire academic dress

You book your academic dress hire when you register to graduate.

You must wear academic dress if you want to attend graduation. You can pay in advance of when you collect your academic dress.

Academic dress can be collected from Academic Dress Hire, 17 George Street Parnell, from Monday 29 April. It can be returned at the graduation venue immediately after the ceremony, or to Academic Dress Hire over the next few days.

Students who are graduating do not need a ticket for themselves, but your guests will need tickets.


All tickets are subject to availability and will be confirmed after registration closes.




#### Programme

If you are not at the Pullman Hotel by 12.00pm, you might not be allowed to attend graduation.



### Graduation protocol

Graduation is a very formal occasion at a formal venue, so please behave respectfully throughout the process and show consideration to all students who are graduating.

You will be given a graduation number when you collect your academic dress. When you arrive for registration at the Pullman Hotel, staff will tell you where to go.

Students proceed into the Princes Ballroom in reverse order of graduating and sit according to this order. It is very important that you stay in the right order, or else you will spoil the experience for yourself and for other students.

Students' names are usually read in groups of three. The group will cross the stage in order, collect their certificates one by one, and shake hands with the Chief Executive.
